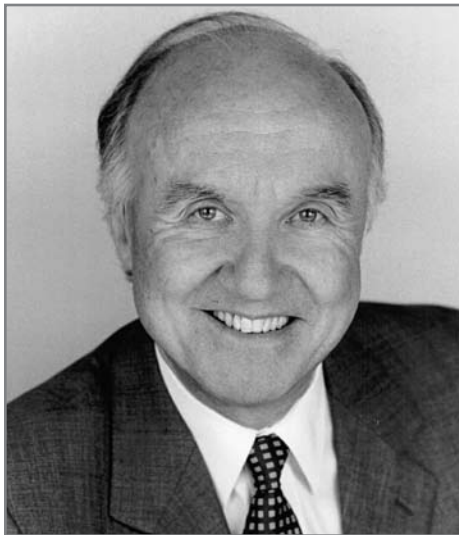

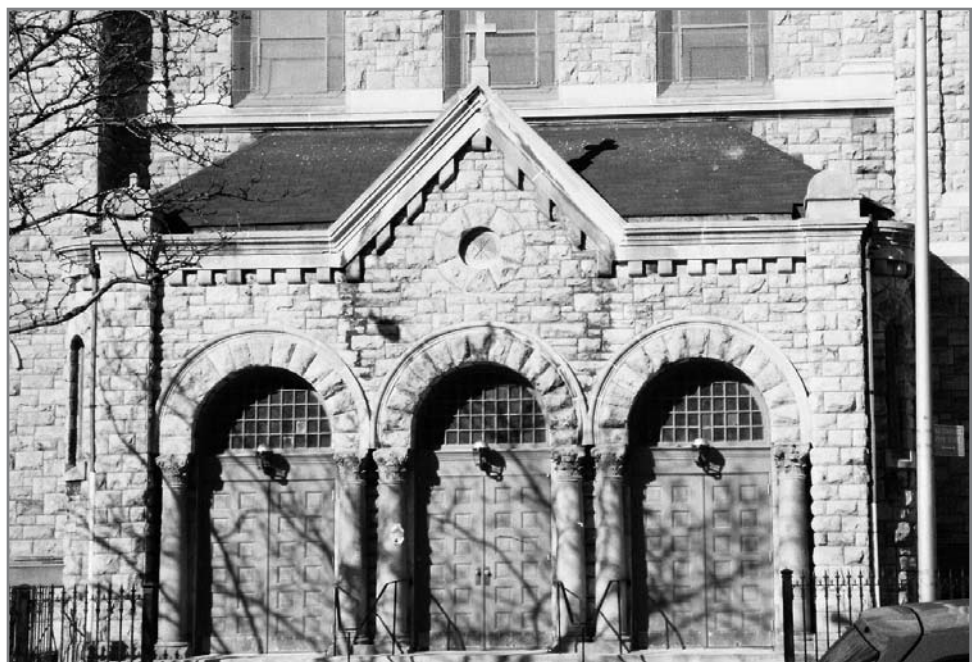

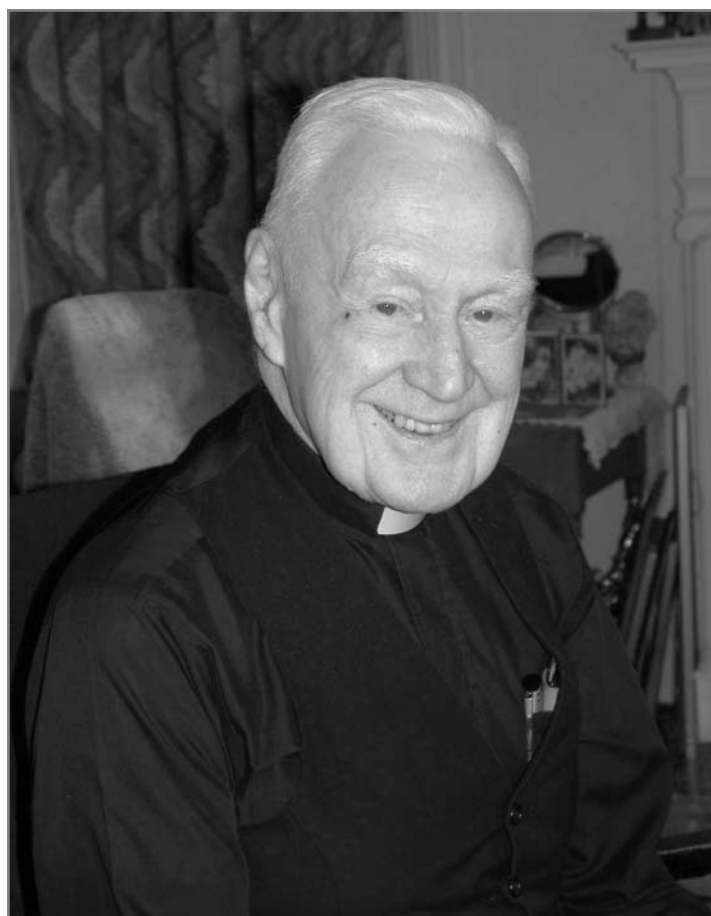
You can make a difference for your school every time you shop for groceries.
